Bylaw No. 513-2003 Of the Town of Coronation In the Province of Alberta

A Bylaw of the Town of Coronation (the "Municipality) to exempt the use of the warning system and stop signals on school buses while loading or unloading school children at the Coronation School.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act*, as amended (the "Act"), the Municipality may by by-law exempt the use of the light warning system and stop signals on the school buses while loading and unloading of school children within the boundaries of the Town of Coronation.

NOW TNHEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORONATION IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOW:

- 1. That an operator of a school bus within the boundaries of the Town of Coronation in the Province of Alberta shall not use the light warning system and stop signal on the school bus while loading and unloading school children.
- 2. That Coronation School make available crossing patrols at the intersection behind the school bus and at the intersection in front of the school bus to warn motorists of school bus loading and unloading of school children and to make motorists aware that school children could be darting between the school buses to the other side of the road.
- 3. This by-law shall take full force and effect upon the date of the final passage thereof.
