#### **NEW BUSINESS**

2021-158 <u>Amendment – 2021 Operating Budget</u>

Moved by Councillor Cook that the Council accepts the following proposed amendments be made to the 2021 Municipal Operating Budget.

The following changes will need to be made to balance the 2021 Municipal Operating Budget and rectify the error of over-stating the minimum tax base.

- 1. Removed \$85,000.00 from the minimum tax line as it was already included in the total taxable for \$1,282,532.20. This will then be broken down to reflect both the total taxable and the minim taxable amounts as follows.
  - a. Total Municipal Taxable as \$ 1,197,532.20
  - b. Total Municipal Minimum Taxable as \$85,000.00
    - i. Total of \$1,282,532.20
- 2. It currently shows as follows.
  - a. Total taxable under municipal as \$1,282,532.20.
  - b. Plus, the Total Municipal Minimum Taxable of \$ 85,000.00
    - i. Total of \$1,367,532.00

This is incorrect as it is overstated and needs to be adjusted to reflect the total of \$1,282,532.20 to be accurate.

The additional amendments that are required to the 2021 Municipal Operating Budget are for the Police Costing, as it was included as revenue. Unfortunately, it was not considered in the expenditures, so the total amount of \$17,463.62 will need to be placed into expenditures.

Leaving a total deficit of \$ 102,463.62.

The following suggested adjustments are recommended to recover a balanced budget for the 2021 year to remove the errors.
